OUR MEMBER REFERRAL PROGRAM!

Have you been wanting a way to give your Member Loyalty payout a boost? Have you been trying to convince your friends and family to become members, but they just haven't felt motivated yet?

If you qualify for Member Loyalty, you'll notice our new Member Referral Program located in your updated Member Loyalty widget on Online and Mobile Banking! Now, you can refer a friend - and you'll both benefit. You just need to share your referral code with a non-member, have them enter it into the code field when applying online or provide it to the representative when applying in-person, and you're on your way to a \$50 referral reward and a boost to your Member Loyalty payout. Your friend or family member will earn a one-time \$350 welcome bonus once they complete all required steps within 60 days of account opening.

The steps they need to complete are:

- Qualify for Member Loyalty (open a checking account and complete at least 5 share withdrawals per month)
- Set up a recurring automatic direct deposit of at least \$200 per month.
