Each year, we host dozens of events in the community to guide students and young adults through a simulation that teaches them the real cost of being an adult. Each student picks a profession, then the game randomizes whether they are married, divorced, have children, need to pay for child support, or have pets. Once these basics are established, the students proceed through the simulation by purchasing essentials like housing, a car, utilities, food, and more.
