2018 Educators Shred Days

Educators Credit Union Shred Days are back! Educators is hosting the 2018 Shred Days at centralized community locations. In recent years, these events have become so popular that some of our branches no longer have the capacity to host them. By having the shred trucks at bigger locations, we can help more people and make sure everyone stays safe.

Remember when coming to shred your documents:

- There is a maximum of five boxes and up to 100 pounds of paper per car. We can only accept paper, no boxes, plastic bags or other materials.
 - Check the documents you are going to shred to ensure you aren't shredding anything important (e.g., birth certificates, social security cards, marriage licenses, etc.).
 - Please remain in your vehicle. We will take care of the heavy lifting.
- If the truck fills before the scheduled end time or there is inclement weather, the remainder of the shred day will be canceled.

Area Students Look Into the Future

Educators Credit Union brought a crucial lesson on money management to nearly 1,500 students in Racine and Milwaukee.

The students lived out a day as an adult during Educators Credit Union's Reality Check Day. Each student was assigned a career, credit score, monthly budget, marital status, and could also have children or pets. They then use their monthly salary to budget key expenses like housing, transportation, groceries, child care and more.

All Racine Unified School District juniors went through the simulation over the course of two days at the Roma Lodge in Racine. The following week, Educators staff and local volunteers then brought Reality Check Day to Milwaukee's Serb Hall for hundreds of students in Milwaukee Public Schools.
